Dear Parishioners,

You may have noticed that your envelopes are a bit different. We have changed the envelope appearance in order to encourage all parishioners to become aware of the need to support **OUR LADY OF LORETTO** Parish.

We are offering parishioners an opportunity to donate to the parish through Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT). The following information answers some of the questions about how Electronic Funds Transfer work and its benefit to the parish.

WHAT IS ELECTRONIC FUNDS TRANSFER?

EFT is an electronic payment service to pay bills, make purchases and conduct banking activity. At **OUR LADY OF LORETTO**, EFT allows parishioners to use this method to make planned charitable contributions to the parish. A designated amount of funds would be transferred from your bank account directly to **OUR LADY OF LORETTO** parish account.

WHAT ARE THE ADVANTAGES OF EFT?

EFT is a win-win for the parish and its parishioners. Have you ever forgotten your envelope donation at home or been away on vacation or gone weekends in summer or during the winter months? The collection basket on Sunday is limited to those who are present during a particular liturgy. With EFT, you have a way to contribute to the parish on a consistent basis. Donors have the flexibility of designating their donations for our regular Sunday collections, and the special collections for Christmas and Easter.

WHAT IF I CHANGE BANKS, OR WANT TO CHANGE THE AMOUNT OF MY OFFERING?

Simply inform the parish office if you need to make any changes.
